Process for dropping off donations

- 1. If you have any symptoms of CoVid-19 please postpone your donation drop-off.
- 2. Arrive during donation drop-off hours and pull up to the spot in front of the door if available.
- 3. Use the intercom to let staff know that you have a donation. Staff may ask you a screening questions about the type of donation.
- 4. Staff or a volunteer will push a bin out to you to load your donation. When you are done a staff or volunteer will retrieve the bin and bring your donation inside the building.

Safety Precautions

- 1. Our staff and volunteers are screened for CoVid-19 symptoms upon arrival on site.
- 2. Staff and volunteers are equipped with PPE (Including masks and gloves).
- 3. The donations drop-off bins are disinfected between each use.
- 4. Donations are received outside the front door, limiting contact on-site.
