Dear Colleagues,

We are a collective of five gender-based violence and Violence Against Women organizations from the London-Middlesex area and we are writing to invite you to be part of a growing national moment of solidarity and support for survivors of sexual violence.

As the Hockey Canada trial continues over the next few weeks, we are witnessing a powerful groundswell of public concern - especially from young people - about rape culture, justice, and survivor dignity. Many survivors across the country are watching, reliving trauma, and wondering if their stories will be met with belief.

At Anova, London Abused Women's Centre, Women's Rural Resource Centre, Changing Ways and The Muslim Centre for Social Support and Integration, we believe they must be. Our organizations serve the London-Middlesex area in southwestern Ontario. For decades, our organizations have been at the forefront of prevention, crisis support, and feminist organizing in our region. Over the past few years, our team has been supporting local survivor-led organizing, and we have personally had the honour of witnessing EM's courage in the courtroom during this trial.

We are launching a national campaign - **#WeBelieveSurvivors** - supported by survivor advocates, educators, and front-line crisis organizations nationwide.

Each day throughout the trial, we will be sharing content to:

- Affirm belief in survivors
- Challenge rape myths (including those related to alcohol)
- Support those disclosing harm.
- Provide healing tools for survivors.
- Invite Canadians to act in solidarity
